McLoughlin Middle School will be holding orientation days for incoming students on the following dates:

- 8th grade students and their parents on August 24th**
- 7th grade students and their parents on August 25th**

Students new to the school district may register for school on August 23rd, between 1:00-3:00 pm.

It is very important that all students attend orientation and they should be accompanied by their parent or guardian.

Times have been set up for you. Coming at the correct time will speed the process along but if your schedule does not allow you to arrive at that time, please come at any of the other times during the day for the specific grade of your child.

Athletic fees may also be paid at this time. The participation fee is \$75.00 per sport per student for the first two sports. The fee must be paid before a student is allowed to participate. Scholarships are available. Please make an appointment to see the Mr. Parsagian, the Athletic Director if you need one.

Once fees have been paid, registration information has been updated and signed by a parent/guardian, students may pick up their class schedule, get their locker assignments, turn in completed athletic packets, pick-up P. E. uniforms, visit the student store and tour the school.

Immunizations - If your student has received any immunizations over the summer, make sure and bring a copy of the records with you to the orientation. Your child should already be up to date with these immunizations and if they are not, they will need to be updated prior to the fall.

- ✓ Second dose of MMR (measles, mumps, rubella)
- ✓ Proof of chicken pox or immunization (Varicella)
- ✓ Hepatitis B immunization (3 dose series over 6 months).

The American Academy of Pediatrics also recommends that adolescents have a booster shot against Pertussis (Whooping Cough). The vaccine "Tdap" provides protection against Tetanus, Diphtheria, and Pertussis and is given as a booster dose to children ages 11-18. Please contact your pediatrician or visit the CDC website at www.cdc.gov/nip for more information about Tdap and other important vaccinations for your pre-teen. This will be required of all incoming seventh graders in the 2010-2011 school year.
