Score Release Dates

Most SAT scores are released about two weeks after test day. June scores take longer, up to six weeks. Important Information:

- Additional Fees apply if you register late or make changes to your test type. (that is, changing from SAT to SAT Subject Tests or vice versa), center or date after registering.
- If you miss the late registration deadline, you may be able to register for the waitlist– check the website to see what is required.

SAT Subject Test Policies:

- You can take up to 3 SAT Subject Tests on a single test date.
- You can not take the SAT Subject Tests and the SAT test on the same test date
- When you register, you must tell us which SAT Subject Test(s) you plan to take. You can change your mind on test day, with limits (check the website for the limits)
- You can take only one Biology Subject Test per test date. After the first 60 questions, you have to choose either Biology Ecological or Biology Molecular; you can not take both
- You can use calculators only on the Mathematics Level 1 and Level 2 Subject Tests
- The Language with Listening tests are offered only in November
- The Language with Listening tests are always given in the first hour of testing. You can take only one Language with Listening test per date.

Fee Waivers– Students who qualify under the following guidelines may get a fee waiver. Fee waivers do not cover the cost of changing your registration, rush scores and phone scores. To get a fee waiver you must complete a Fee Waiver Request form and submit it to the Tornado Future Center.

- You're eligible for fee waivers if you say "yes" to any of these items:
- You're enrolled in or eligible to participate in the National School Lunch Program (NSLP).
- Your annual family income falls within the [Income Eligibility Guidelines](#) set by the USDA Food and Nutrition Service.
- You're enrolled in a federal, state, or local program that aids students from low-income families (e.g., Federal TRIO programs such as Upward Bound).
- Your family receives public assistance.
- You live in federally subsidized public housing or a foster home, or are homeless.
- You are a ward of the state or an orphan.

If you are testing on a national test date and can't afford the registration fee for the ACT or ACT with writing, you may be eligible for an [ACT Fee Waiver](#). Information about the eligibility requirements and how to request a fee waiver is sent each summer to high schools. You should work with your local high school to determine your eligibility.

You must meet all of the following requirements:

1. Currently enrolled in high school in the 11th or 12th grade.
2. Either a United States citizen or testing in the US, US territories, or Puerto Rico.
3. Meet one or more indicators of economic need listed on the ACT Fee Waiver form.

If you are eligible, you may use a maximum of **two** separate fee waivers total. The waiver is used once you register, even if you do not test on the requested test date.

IMPORTANT: To take full advantage of the waiver, you must follow through and test on your registered test date.

Fee waivers cover **only** the basic registration fee for your test option on a national test date, including up to four college choices (if you provide valid codes when you register). Waivers do not cover the late registration fee, test date or test center changes, [standby fee](#), additional score reports, or any other services.

You **cannot** request a fee waiver directly from ACT; you must contact your high school counselor. If you receive an ACT Fee Waiver Form, follow the "How to Apply this Fee Waiver" on it for your registration method (or if requesting Special Testing).

Note: If you register online, and register during the late period or request any additional services, you **must** enter a credit card to pay those fees before submitting your registration.
