- Information related to school and parent programs, meetings, and other activities will be communicated in both English and Spanish to parents through the timely notes and invitations sent home with students.
- Classroom teachers will provide achievement test information during conferences, meetings, and printed information that is sent home.
- The Teacher-Student-Parent contract outlines how teachers, students, and the parents will share the responsibility for improved student's achievement.

Parent Participation:

- Parents will receive materials and have opportunities to participate in school-family evening activities planned throughout the year.
- Parents will have opportunities to participate in school decision-making regarding the education of their children through Family Night, Site Council, and Parent-Teacher Conferences. Child care will be provided for some of these events.
- Parents will be encouraged to work jointly with the school to develop a Teacher-Student-Parent Contract
- The school will provide opportunities for conferences, as requested by parents, to ask questions about the district's curriculum, to formulate suggestions and to make decisions regarding the education of their children.
- Within established parameters, parents are encouraged to observe instruction and other school activities that involve their student.
- Parents are encouraged to volunteer and help at school in their child's classroom as a VIM, at school events, and as a Site Council participant.

Meetings:

- Parents will be informed through notices sent home, at drive through registration, through automated phone calls, and at the annual Title One meeting, the requirements of the program, and their rights to be involved.
