

Roosevelt's Family Engagement Plan 2019-20

As a Title I school, a goal of Roosevelt Elementary is to encourage family involvement in the education of each child.

Our Family Engagement Plan has been developed by the Site Council and Roosevelt staff members. We encourage parents to become part of the Site Council where school-wide decisions are made regarding each child's education. The bulleted list below includes how Roosevelt School plans to distribute information, provide opportunities for family participation, and inform through meetings.

Providing Information:

- Families are welcome to access school and student academic information through Roosevelt's: website, Facebook page, email, One Call, & event listings on Peach Jar (found on district website). Parent computers are available in our Main Commons to check school district website and school Facebook.
- Look for our Family Engagement Plan: sent home annually to parents, posted in school office area, Parent Handbook, & Roosevelt website under Title 1.
- Information related to school and parent programs, meetings, and activities will be communicated in English and Spanish through: timely notes, invitations, emails, and newsletters sent home with students.
- Classroom teachers will provide achievement test information via: Report to Parents, parent/teacher conferences, meetings, & printed information that is sent home.
- The Family & School Compact Agreement outlines how teachers, students, parents, and the Principal will share the responsibility for improved student achievement.

Participation:

- Parents will have opportunities to participate in morning & evening school activities.
- Parents will have opportunity to participate in school decision-making regarding the education of their children. Opportunities include: Parent Teacher Organization (PTO), Open House, Site Council, & parent-teacher conferences. Child-care and/or interpretation for Spanish language speakers will be provided at some events.
- Parents will be encouraged to work jointly with the school to review and update both our Family & School Compact Agreement and our Family Engagement Plan.
- Each teacher is available for a parent/teacher conference to allow parents time to: ask questions about District curriculum, formulate suggestions, and make decisions regarding the education of their child.
- Within established guidelines, parents are encouraged to observe instruction and other school activities involving their child.
- Parents are encouraged to V.I.M. (Volunteer in Medford schools): In their child's classroom, in the school library, Title 1, P.E., after-school activities, and for parent event preparation. Contact the office if interested.
- Parents are encouraged to check school bulletin boards for updated information.

Meetings:

- Parents will be informed, through Open House and notices sent home, of the school's participation in the Title I program, the requirements of the program, and rights for being involved.
- Parent meetings will be held at various times to accommodate the needs of families. Interpreters will be provided as needed.
