

Oak Grove Elementary Parent Involvement Plan

The Oak Grove Elementary Parent Involvement Plan has been developed by the Site Council and staff. Parents are encouraged to be a part of the Site Council as decisions are made regarding their children's education.

Distribution of Information:

- Parents can access updated school information and student academic information at the school's website and P.A.L.
- The Parent Involvement Plan will be posted in the school office area as well in the Parent-Student handbook. A copy of this plan will be sent home annually to parents.
- Information related to school and parent programs, meetings, and other activities will be communicated in both English and Spanish to parents through the timely notes and invitations sent home with students
- Classroom teachers will provide achievement test information during requested conferences, meetings, and printed information that is sent home.
- The Teacher-Student-Parent compact outlines how teachers, students, and the parents will share the responsibility for improving student's achievement.
- We will use the one call phone system to get some school information to parents.

Parent Participation:

- Parents will receive materials and have opportunities to participate in school-family evening activities planned throughout the year.
- Parents will have opportunities to participate in school decision-making regarding the education of their children through Open House, Site Council, scheduled and/or requested parent-teacher conferences, and the PTO.
- Parents will be encouraged to work jointly with the school to develop a Teacher-Student-Parent Compact.
- The school will provide opportunities for conferences, as requested by parents, to ask questions about the District's curriculum, to formulate suggestions and to make decisions regarding the education of their children.
- Within established parameters, parents are encouraged to observe instruction and other school activities that involve his/her child.
- Parents are encouraged to volunteer and help at school in their child's classroom as a VIM, at school events, and as a PTO participant.

Meetings:

- Parents will be informed through notices sent home, at the annual Fall Open House and at PTO meetings of the school's participation in the Title 1 program, the requirements of the program, and their rights to be involved.
- Parent meetings will be held at various times to accommodate the needs of families. Interpreters will be provided as needed.
- Title 1 will provide for child care for the PTO Meetings.
